  - Creating the legal framework for holding fossil fuel companies accountable: & they have to contribute to a fund allocated towards climate change adaptation projects. We're signaling to the Borough that we support this in Highland Park to indicate to the state that multiple boroughs support this, and hopefully this will put pressure on NJ will decide to pass this. This is a statement from constituents to our elected officials.

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- Matt Hersh to take this to the DPW and move this resolution through quickly for the February 5, 2025 Mayor & Council meeting
- Leadership transition, call for nominations - <https://forms.gle/SFcj848eZVZkFMxv7> - by Feb. 19
  - Sheree - there should be co-chairs for each committee and they should be part of a leadership team/executive committee that meets outside of the monthly meeting
  - Tina & Sheree are going to co-chair the Earth Day Fair
  - What structure are we looking at for SHP?
    - 2 co-chairs for SHP
    - 1-2 individuals for each committee
    - *Need to put more thought into*
- Jake Callahan - Asst. Borough Administrator (replaced Emma). Working on Sustainable Jersey certification
  - A lot of our actions expired on January 1. Want to get them back.
  - Some expired a few years ago. See if we can get them back
    - Ex: Green fair action expired 2-3 years ago, but we had one last year, so Jake needs to put together info for the application
  - Explore new ones. What are some easy ones to start with?
  - We currently have Silver certification (highest certification level). We can get gold in certain areas but there isn't a gold SJ certification.
  - Tina - We want to ensure that what we're doing matches the Sustainable Jersey actions so we get points
  - Matt - it's important for SHP to understand what actions need to be re-upped each year
  - Randy - every action has an expiration date, but something like an ordinance will continue. You need to show proof for each action and it takes time to track down everything. We need to document everything. Look at everything we're currently doing & look at the SJ actions. Think strategically about the 1 or 2 things we want to add each year.
  - Jake has a targeted list of actions for this year and will share it with us. Some actions need extra documentation
  - Meli - there should be more transparency from the borough so we can complete more actions. And more communication from the borough about what we're doing/accomplishing

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- Tina - there should be a committee of an SHP co-chair & 2 other people who meet with Jake & Matt and communicate back to us. There's been a gap in communication between the borough and SHP
- Sheree - recommends that we see an application for an action & also read all the SJ actions <https://www.sustainablejersey.com/actions/>
- Matt - we should identify 1 or 2 big actions at the start of the year
- **Highland Park is top 10 in the state!**
- Rose - recommends that we document the history of our SJ certification and it can possibly go on our website. *Meli can work with the high school to write a history of the environmental club at the HS (not a priority right now)*
- Next steps:
  - Find a time for Randy to meet with us before the next meeting to navigate us on the SJ website & share more about it
  - Jake to share his spreadsheet of actions with us
